The patented FIT4YOU technology lies at the heart of the new FitEvolution range: an innovative pressing process is applied to create a hollow in the penetration proof insole, for the insertion of one of three ETPU inserts, provided with footwear, between the outsole and footbed. Expanded Thermoplastic Polyurethane, a material renowned for its excellent shock absorbing properties, and three inserts of different density - soft, medium and hard, provide different comfort levels for the wearer's well-being, reducing joint fatigue and ensuring personalised comfort for the entire working day.



The main advantages of the new Beta FitEvolution footwear line:

- **Customised comfort**: with three inserts of different densities; choose the level of shoe softness and support that best suits you, according to weight, height and personal use requirements.
- Well-being for your feet: fit 11 provides loose and optimal wearability, ensuring superior comfort of the foot inside the shoe.
- **Duration and resistance**: the anatomical detachable footbed, positioned above the ETPU insert, provides added protection, for a longer-lasting insert and shoe.
- Advanced protection: the toe cap and 100% metal-free composite insole provide total protection, without compromising on lightness and comfort.
- **Superior adherence**: the dual-density polyurethane outsole guarantees perfect adherence on any surface, improving stability and safety.
