Taking centre stage in the new range is the elegant and contemporary **Racing Grey** colour, alongside **anthracite, red** and **Beta's iconic orange**.

The Unique Features of the New RSC39 Tool Trolley

SMART ORGANISATION AND MAXIMUM PRODUCTIVITY

- **Tool panel with integrated retractable "In & Out" system**, built into the worktop and with a load capacity of **up to 5 kg**. It keeps **tools clearly visible and always within easy reach**, while allowing them to be neatly and securely stored inside the trolley at the end of the job thanks to the retractable piston system and dedicated lock.

DISTINCTIVE DESIGN AND SUPERIOR COMFORT

- **Reinforced ABS worktop** with the new Beta texture, **recessed handles with a quick-release opening system** for practical and immediate access to the drawers, while also contributing to the trolley's clean, contemporary appearance. The **increased height** compared with

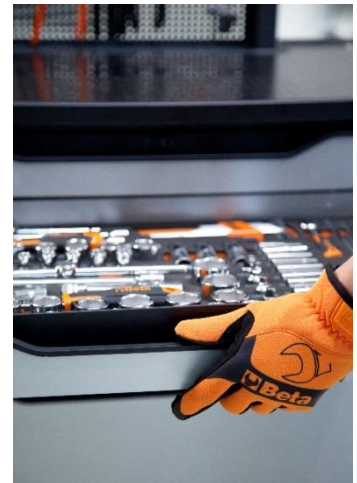
current models in the range (1,450 mm with the tool panel raised and 1,015 mm with the panel closed) makes working even more comfortable.

ROBUST CONSTRUCTION AND HIGH LOAD CAPACITY

- Static load capacity of **up to 1,000 kg**, allowing the cab to support heavy loads and withstand even the most demanding tasks. Robust and **easy-to-manoeuve Ø125 mm non-marking castors** make it easy to move the cab without leaving marks or abrasions on the floor.

MAXIMUM CUSTOMISATION AND SECURITY

- Maximum **freedom in drawer configuration**, with the option of inserting up to four trays in soft EVA or thermoformed ABS, keeping tools neatly organised, protected and easily accessible. A range of **accessories can be integrated**, while a **central locking system** simultaneously secures all drawers and a dedicated key lock protects the perforated tool panel, ensuring maximum tool security.



The RSC39 also stands out for its **modular design** and the possibility of customising it over time: it can be enhanced with **accessories** such as a document holder, a folding shelf that provides an additional work surface, and a computer bracket.



The RSC39 mobile roller cab is available in **5-, 7- or 8-drawer configurations**, with standard drawer dimensions (588 x 367 mm), making them compatible with Beta's extensive range of tool modules.

Through the **online configurator**, every professional can select the accessories, modules and tools best suited to their needs, creating a tailor-made workstation that is organised and can be further **customised over time**.
